Wanted to let everyone know how and what we are doing.

God has allowed things to continue to move forward on our building. We lay the foundation next Monday, June 18. I am attaching some pictures of our preparations.

I have told our people that if we are going to pray that God provides the money for us to build the building, then we need to be preparing for doing the building. So, we have been getting ready. We are making our own bricks. Some of the pictures show us stacking the bricks preparing to fire them. We will need 2500 for the foundation. The stack has a few over 3000.

We have measured and laid out the area where we want the building.

We are still about \$4000 short of what we need. If you are able to help, we would appreciate it very much.

Debi and I are doing well. Debi had flu for last week or so; but, is now over it.

We have had visitors in church the last few Sundays. I was invited to a boma this last week to explain the Gospel. The two elders of the boma have a business selling home made alcohol. They were convicted of their need for salvation; but, are hesitating because they understand that they would have to give up this business. Please be in Prayer for these.

We are taking some of our young people to youth camp next week. Please pray that God will use us this week to help them grow in grace.

I am going to try attaching the pictures this time instead of putting them in the email. If you are not able to view them, please let me know and I will send them to you in an email.

In the picture of the two men and beautiful woman (the beautiful woman is my wife, Debi), the man on the left is Penuel our interpreter and the man on the right is Bonaphas. In the picture of Bonaphas and the child, she is Penuel's little daughter, Nesserian. Bonaphas has surrendered to preach. He has just finished the second set of lessons toward that end. He has one more set of lessons and then he will start attending the Bible institute that Team Tanzania runs. He is now associate to the Pastor. He leads all of the worship service except the preaching and does that sometime. Please be in prayer for him as he continues to his calling.

Please remember that we are coming back to the US on furlough starting in October 2007 and staying until May 2008. If you would like us to report to your church, please let me know so we can arrange a date.
