Dear pastors and friends,

Let me start out this letter with a Big Praise the Lord. We serve a God that takes care of us in so many ways.

I am writing this to let you all know of what happened this last week. As you may all know, Ron and I were scheduled to return to Tanzania tomorrow June 3rd. This past Monday, Ron was in the hospital having a minor blockage in his heart taken care of and that all went very well with no complications. We are so thankful for that and praised the Lord that we would be able to still leave on June 3rd. I guess the devil wasn't satisfied with that minor hiccup. So as Ron was delivering the van that we had rented on Friday, he was broad-sided by a vehicle traveling at about 70 mph. This in turn flipped the van 3 times, crushed in the roof, left Ron dangling upside down, and he had to break out the window then crawl out. We are amazed that he wasn't killed as people die of less than this all the time. We can only think that God hasn't finished with him in Tanzania yet. In saying this, he is not doing all that well as of this writing. He cannot move his left shoulder and today he will visit another doctor to look at it and also his stomach. He has been having severe stomach discomfort since this happened and we are concerned that something has been torn inside. The place that we rented the car from will be sending pictures of the van and I will be forwarding them to you as soon as I get them.

All of this said, I would first ask you pray that he recovers fully and speedily. Secondly, this has put us at an increased financial burden with the doctor visits, the additional living expenses here, the change of our tickets for travel, and now the vehicle rental vehicle from Enterprise so that we have transportation. All this is extra funds that to be honest, we just don't really have.

I know you get requests from missionaries for money for different needs all the time. However, if there is any way possible to send in some money to the mission office to help us out at this time, it would be greatly appreciated.

We are not sure how much this will be in total for additional funds as we are still kind of in shock at what has happened. I shall be sending updates of his progress as soon as I get any news.

Thanking all of you in advance for anything you can do to help us at this time.
